Finger safe seals are attached to internal doors. All elements of the museum are constantly monitored and modified to meet current safety standards. If someone blocks the doors of the lift when it is closing, the motor tries to keep going increasing the amount of electricity flowing through it. This triggers a switch which reverses the motor, opening the doors again  EUREKA! actively promotes that all children must be supervised by an adult at all times. We act on any reported cases of children not supervised whilst visiting. | Emergency button in lift, hazard tape around the door to show finger trap area and safe waiting area.
